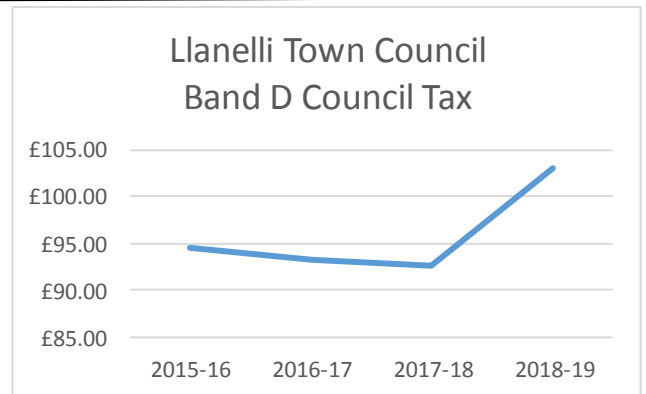


LLANELLI TOWN COUNCIL COUNCIL TAX NOTICE 2018/2019

Llanelli Town Council will precept £900,000 to be levied against the Council Taxpayers of Llanelli in order that the council can continue to maintain and improve the services important to our community. This is the first increase since the 2014-15 Financial Year. Band D properties will therefore see an increase in Council Tax from £92.52 in 2017-18 to £103.04 in 2018-19



RECREATION AND SPORT

The Town Council provides excellent facilities at Stebonheath, home to Llanelli Town Football Club and West Wales Raiders Rugby League and at the Selwyn Samuel Centre. With Asset Transfer from the County Council nearing completion, the Town Council, with the support of local organisations and sports groups, has taken responsibility for Crown Park, Havelock Park, Parc y Dre and Penyfan Park under a long term lease from 1st April 2017. The Council also works with the County Council to maintain Penygaer Playing Fields. The Town Council works in partnership with the County Council to jointly fund the costs of Parc Howard, ensuring the facility is improved and remains in public ownership.



LLANELLI CEMETERY

Llanelli Town Council works in partnership with Llanelli Rural Council on the Llanelli Joint Burial Advisory Committee, this Committee manages Llanelli Cemetery.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

The Council owns and manages seven community centres providing subsidised facilities for use by the public of all ages. Additionally, it advises and assists community groups on a wide range of issues and provides grants to support the work of many local clubs, societies and organisations.

FOOTPATHS AND LIGHTING

The Council contributes to the cost of an inspection and trashing programme along the town's public footpaths and also pays for the street lighting in a number of areas.

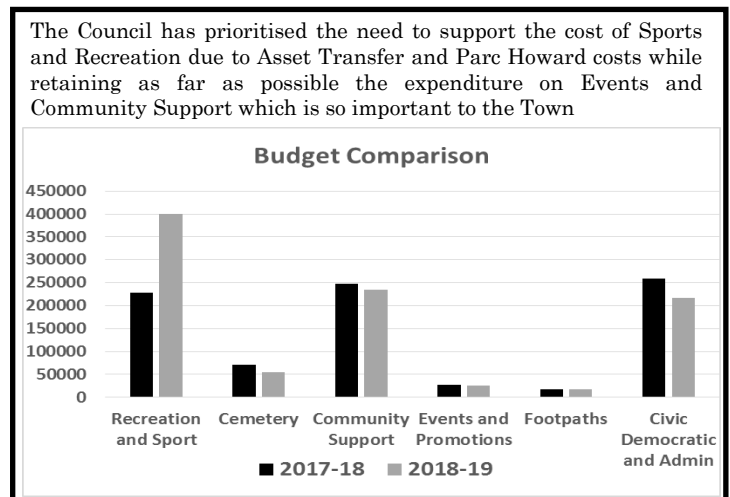
CIVIC, DEMOCRATIC & ADMIN

These are the costs of managing Council facilities and activities within the Community along with Council committees and the mayoralty.

EVENTS & PROMOTIONS

The Town Council funds the provision and maintenance of the Hanging Baskets in the Town Centre, these provide a blaze of colour through the summer months. The Council works closely with other organisations such as Y Lle and the Llanelli Business Improvement District to support a number of events arranged during the year. The Council also works with the County Council and Llanelli Rural Council to arrange and fund the Annual Christmas Carnival.
