
LLANELLI TOWN COUNCIL COUNCIL TAX NOTICE

2021/2022

In order that the Council can continue to maintain and improve the services important to our community, Llanelli Town Council will for 2021-22 retain its precept to be levied against the Council Taxpayers of Llanelli at £950,000. This will result in Band D properties seeing a decrease in Council Tax from £106.70 in 2020-21 to £106.26 in 2021-22.



RECREATION AND SPORT

The Town Council provides excellent facilities at Stebonheath, home to Llanelli Town Football Club and West Wales Raiders Rugby League, and at the Selwyn Samuel Centre. The Council manages parks and playing fields at Clos yr Ysgol, Crown Park, Havelock Park, Morfa Park, Nightingale Court, Peoples' Park and Penyfan Park, with the new park at Ann Street to follow into Town Council management shortly. The Council continues to work with the County Council to maintain Penygaer Playing Fields and through the Town Council's financial contribution and membership of the Parc Howard Collaboration Group works in partnership with the County Council to manage Parc Howard, ensuring

EVENTS AND PROMOTIONS

The Town Council funds the provision and maintenance of the Hanging Baskets in the Town Centre, these provide a blaze of colour through the summer months. The Council works closely with the Llanelli Business Improvement District to support a number of town centre events arranged during the year which currently include the 80's Music Festival, Food Festival and Reindeer Parade. The Council also works with the County Council and Llanelli Rural Council to arrange and fund the Annual Christmas Carnival.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

The Council owns and manages seven community centres providing subsidised facilities for use by the public of all ages. Additionally, it advises and assists community groups on a wide range of issues and provides grants and sponsorship to support the work of many local clubs, societies and organisations. Our Community Development Officer continues to work with many organisations delivering a wide range of projects throughout our community.

FOOTPATHS AND LIGHTING

The Town Council continues to inspect and trash the town's public footpaths on behalf of the County Council and will be undertaking a programme of improvements to some of the pathways. The Council also funds the energy and maintenance costs of the street lighting on these pathways.

CIVIC, DEMOCRATIC AND ADMIN

These are the costs of managing Council facilities and activities within the Community along with Council committees and the mayoralty.

CULTURAL AND HERITAGE

Llanelli Town Council owns Llanelly House which it has leased to CHRT on a long lease. The Town Council and the County Council continue to support the House to ensure that the Grade I listed building is maintained to the high standards already being set enabling it to be a significant asset to the town centre and its visitors.

COVID19

The impact of COVID19 continues to be felt in Llanelli, the Town Council will continue to seek ways to support the Llanelli Community as we move forward. During 2020-21 the Council has carried out a number of actions including supporting foodbanks, soup kitchens and free school meals projects with food and products, providing support to deliver pharmacy prescriptions to residents and has provided the Selwyn Samuel Centre to the Hywel Dda Health Board to be used as a field hospital. The Town Council in partnership with the Llanelli Business Improvement District and Carmarthenshire County Council have also provided local pubs and café's with equipment to support social distancing in their re-opening following COVID restrictions being lifted.
