#### COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND UPDATE

#### (1) UPDATES AND ACTIVITIES

#### **Community**

Meet the Mayor and Civic Structures – Officers facilitated alongside Town Mayor Cllr Pearce in the delivery of 3 workshops with Coedcae and Bryngwyn schools and Coleg Sir Gâr. The workshops work along the national curriculum. 79 young people took part in the workshops. A further workshop took place at Coleg Sir Gar with 93 young people on the Public Services Course. Meet the Mayor for the 8 primary schools (240 young people will be invited) is planned for March 2024. The focus in the New year will be the completion of the online democracy information webpage which will be shaped by young people from the College. Meetings continue to take place with Louise Morgan of the Carmarthenshire County Council democracy improvements team.

Christmas Activity 2023 – The Christmas period in 2023 has seen a number of activities from the Mayors Christmas card design by Old Road School, support for community groups Christmas activities and support for the Christmas food hamper scheme with Llanelli Community Partnership. During December support has been given to the Food Stations with visits undertaken to food banks.

Cook / Skills 24 – Officers continue to support Cook24 to connect within our 8 primary schools offering basic cooking skills onsite and visits to local food producers. The project will run alongside the National Curriculum and will be a free resource for the College. The project launches on the 26<sup>th</sup> January with food stalls and demonstrations at the Antioch Centre where the project will be based for the remainder of 2024. All are welcome.

**Armed Force Covenant** – Llanelli Town Council has a good working relationship with the Armed Forces Covenant Coordinator with Officers attending the Covenant meetings which are held every 4 months. Support is given to a number of projects in Llanelli that includes The Links project, The Breakfast Clubs and national events such as Armed Forces Day and Remembrance Sunday. 2024 will see the 80th anniversary of the D-Day Landings with consideration being given by Veteran's Groups to possible events to mark the anniversary.

**Penygaer / Crown Park / Community Sensory Garden** – Members, Officers and volunteers have been working hard to create the Penygaer Sensory Garden. October and November have seen work carried out on sleeper beds, wildflower turf, bulb planting and over 60 tree saplings from the Woodlands Trust being planted. A further 120 sapling trees have been planted in December in 4 locations in Crown Park. Penygaer school continues with their filming project on the garden which forms part of their work for this year's curriculum for year 6 with a logo design presentation with the Community Green Network taking place in early December.

Further information will follow.

#### SPORT, YOUTH AND ACTIVITES OFFICER'S REPORT

## Review of service provision in Llanelli, Meetings, Gaps, and Opportunities.

The Sports, Youth and Activities programme includes an update on action taken and being developed in line with the Future Generation Act and targets goals set by Carmarthenshire Public Service Board for 2024.

#### (1) Community & School Activities

- New Year Activities Emails to schools & social media posts promoting the new year activities timetable for the wards of Llanelli are being published, providing opportunities to experience a range of sporting sessions. The sessions at the Cruyff Court through 2023 have seen an increase to an average of 25 children taking part in each session.
- Schools Sessions Sessions and Activities are being run within Stebonheath School & Old Road School to develop and broaden the primary schools' teachers' ideas and perception on physical education lessons. This is helping to provide and establish links with school sport and community sport. A variation of sports and activities will be played at the end of the school term, opportunities will be given for community clubs to signpost pupils to their clubs.
- Coleg Sir Gar ALN & Strade Youth Leader Coleg Sir Gar's Additional Learning Needs (ALN) unit bowling sessions have been a great success. The sessions with the SYAO in partnership with Llanelli Indoor Bowls club has seen around 25 weekly participants of the college attend the session at the Selwyn Samuel Centre. Strade's Youth Leaders programme from last year have also shown an interest in assisting the delivery of the bowls sessions in the new year.
- Scarlets Girls Only Festival Alongside the Scarlets Community team, 14 Llanelli & District schools brought a girl only team to Coleg Sir Gar for an inspiring day of tag rugby. Scarlets U18 ladies team officiated the games in addition to the Scarlet's interns. Tesco Community Champion Lisa Lewis supported the girls in their activities by providing the schools with water and fruit. In 2024 a key focus with The Scarlets will be to develop the player pathway for young female rugby players.
- Nursery Sessions Nursery & Toddler sessions have been organised with Cylch Meithrin Llanerch & Morfa Family Centre, with St Pauls due to confirm. This will support the nursery and family centre staff in delivering activities to promote keeping active and healthy while tackling the rising percentage of children obesity levels within Llanelli.
- Cruyffian Course Training The SYA Officer attended an insightful two-day course in Liverpool's Anfield Community Complex with other organizations attending who also have Cruyff Courts. Good practice and different projects we're discussed to establish a connection between the courts across Wales, England and Scotland. Links have been established between Everton FC in the Community & Liverpool FC Foundation to look at the possibility for a court twinning between the organisations. Equipment & Small-scale funding have also been given by the Cruyff Foundation to support future work in 2024. A meeting and review with the Foundation took place in December with the Foundation reporting that they are pleased with the work undertaken at the Court to date. Further branded signage at the court will go up in the new year.

- Syrian Sir Gar End of Year Celebration In partnership with Syria Sir Gar Wesleyan Community Centre hosted fun mini games for the group. In addition to the check in it was an opportunity to consult with the children on a future work programme. The children spoke of their day-to-day struggles with racism and methods in which this could be reduced and avoided, their coping practices and where they play in Penyfan. Sessions are due to resume in January 2024.
- Carmarthenshire Sports Network Llanelli Town Council have been invited to take part in the new Carmarthenshire Sports Partnership, to be a part of the bigger scheme of the new 'Sports Partnership' there are five sport partnerships spanning across Wales. Llanelli falls into the Southwest Wales region. The new Sport Wales initiative connects sports across Wales encouraging National Governing Bodies such as WRU, FAW, Welsh Athletics to work more closely with the likes of Llanelli Town Council and other sports delivering organisations. The first meeting was held in Carmarthen Leisure Centre on the 18<sup>th</sup> December.
- LMCN 'New Year, New Me' Following consultation with the Llanelli Multi Cultural Network and the Hywel Dda University Health Board, 2024 will see the introduction of the 'New Year, New Me' scheme which will consist of chair-based activities and light exercise to keep the participants fit and healthy while the NHS staff will promote healthy eating. This will happen every first Tuesday of the month through 2024.
