### 36. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND SPORTS, YOUTH AND ACTIVITIES REPORT

Further to Minute No. 24 of the Town Council Ordinary meeting of 5<sup>th</sup> June 2024, consideration was given to the Principal Officer and the Sports Youth and Activity Officer's report (copies having been previously circulated to members). The report dealt with the following:

#### (1) Community & School Activities

- **Euro's Football Event** – The event held at Ysgol Penrhos 3G facility saw 190 pupils attend. The football festival was restricted to pupils who did not have the opportunity to play for a grassroots club. The day promoted football to those who may have social and economic barriers preventing them from playing football. In addition, it gave an opportunity to those who do not usually represent the school to play noncompetitive games against other Llanelli based schools. The event was held in partnership with Actif Sir Gar and was well attended.
- **People's Park Wellbeing Walk** – The second wellbeing walk was held on the 13<sup>th</sup> June at Peoples' Park in partnership with the Llanelli Community Partnership. It highlighted the green space areas at Peoples' Park. Thirty people attended the walk despite the wet weather. The walk and talk gave an opportunity to talk about issues and generally giving time to reflect and to create friendships along the way. The group learnt about the former Castle and the water ecosystem at Pont Twyn and the Welsh Water flooding Raincape programme. Parc y Dre Park Bowls Club kindly opened the pavilion to allow well earned refreshments and buffet to be served.

- **Nation of Sanctuary Awards** – The Town Council’s Sport’s Youth & Activities services in partnership with Syria Sir Gar received a runner up certificate at the Nation of Sanctuary Awards 2024 organised by the Welsh Refugee Council. The award was won by the Welsh Rugby Union. It was noted that the Chief Executive had commented on how refreshing it is to see a Town Council supporting these communities.
- **Summer Community Timetable** – Daily Summer holiday community activities sessions utilising Town Council facilities and green spaces were published on social media and sent to all local primary schools. It would allow children to keep active throughout the summer holiday. Sessions would include linking in with local bowls clubs as well as paddling pool sessions throughout the holidays.
- **Old Road School** – As in previous years Old Road school were running an after-school sports club for six weeks. The project was an opportunity for the teachers to gain ideas and experience when leading physical education classes through the year. Upskilling the sporting provision provided by teachers would allow for a sustainable method allowing children to engage in sporting activities. This year they had also requested the support of officers with their upcoming sports day.
- **Angor Community Cancer Service** – The community development service had long been working to support those in the community that are learning to live with cancer. The Angor charity with Dr Anita Huws taking the lead from the Breast Care Unit in Prince Phillip Hospital. The concept for *Angor* started over 15 years ago when it became apparent that there was a real need for a support service in Carmarthenshire for individuals who have been diagnosed with cancer or a life-altering diagnosis.

*Angor* was a charity made up of like-minded individuals from various walks of life who understood the impact that a life altering diagnosis could cause, and who aspired to enable and support the transformation of individuals by providing an informed and holistic service building hope and strength. Providing a pathway from clinical services back to the community. The Town Council service would be supporting an outreach service in Llanelli, looking at physical activity and eating well with cancer through Cook24. It was hoped that the charity would be eventually based at Pentre Awel.

- **Upcoming Events** – Llanelli Town Council would be supporting local events over the summer holidays with activities provision. Some of the events were Fit & Fun Camps held with Carmarthenshire County Council, Transforming Tyisha event with Carmarthenshire County Council, Tyisha Big Day Out with Tyisha positive action group, Stebo Skills Day with Llanelli Youth Theatre Group, Fun Day Out with the Scarlets and Fit Fed & Fun Camp with the Welsh Rugby Union
