Hi everyone,

We are writing to let you know that the current Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) for Llanelli Town Centre is now due for review, in line with the three-year period set when the Order was introduced in 2023.

As you will be aware, the PSPO was introduced to address alcohol and drug related anti-social behaviour. It gives powers to manage alcohol consumption and to confiscate alcohol and drug paraphernalia where needed.

You can view the current Order, including the map and conditions, on the Council's website:

As part of the review, the Council will:

- Look at how effective the current Order has been and the impact it has had
- Gather feedback from stakeholders on current issues and any emerging concerns
- Consider whether changes or updates are needed

This will include looking at whether additional powers, such as dispersal powers, could be included in a revised Order, subject to legal advice and any relevant case law.

The Order will also go out to full public consultation from September 2026.

To support the review, we would welcome the opportunity to join any existing meetings you have where we could give you some more information and so that you can help inform the next steps. This will give you the chance to:

- Share your experience of how the PSPO is working in practice
- Highlight any ongoing or new concerns
- Help shape any proposed changes

Hi everyone,

We are writing to let you know that the Council is considering the introduction of a **vehicle-related Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) for the North Dock area of Llanelli**.

This proposal is being developed in response to concerns raised by residents, businesses, and other stakeholders regarding vehicle-related anti-social behaviour within the area. Reported issues include dangerous or inconsiderate driving, excessive vehicle noise, and other activities that have a detrimental impact on the quality of life of those who live in, work in, or visit North Dock.

As part of this work, the Council will:

- Consider the evidence gathered regarding vehicle-related anti-social behaviour within the area
- Gather feedback from stakeholders on the nature and extent of the issues being experienced
- Consider whether a PSPO would be an appropriate and proportionate way of addressing these issues
- Consider what restrictions or conditions, if any, should be included within any proposed Order

The Council will also undertake a full public consultation from September 2026 to give residents, businesses, visitors, and users of the area the opportunity to share their views before any decision is made.

To support this work, we would welcome the opportunity to join any existing meetings you have where we could provide further information on the proposal and hear your views to help inform the next steps. This will give you the chance to:

- Share your experiences of vehicle-related issues within the North Dock area
- Highlight any ongoing or emerging concerns
- Help inform and shape any proposed Order

Could you please reply to this email with details of any upcoming meetings that we could attend. We can also consider arranging a dedicated session for invited stakeholders if that would be more beneficial.
